

Configure your public website

Once installed, you can configure your public website to display one or more components to users.

An example of the HTML required can be found in the 'Public Site' folder, but in essence:

Include a version of jquery:

```
<script type="text/javascript" src="http://code.jquery.com/jquery-1.12.0.min.js"></script>
```

Include the iframesizer script from the 'Public Site' folder and reference it:

```
<script src="iframeSizer.min.js" type="text/javascript"></script>
```

Use one or more of the following codes to display the corresponding component. Remember to change the server address to your public-facing IIS server!

Custom connection box

```
<iframe src="https://<serverfqdn>/rlestat/generaterdp.aspx" style="border:0; width: 100%; max-width: 600px; height: 260px;" scrolling="no"></iframe>
```

Active Users Bars

```
<iframe src="https://<serverfqdn>/rlestat/hostload.aspx" style="border:0; width: 100%; max-width: 500px; height: 230px;" scrolling="no"></iframe>
```

24-Hour History

```
<iframe src="https://<serverfqdn>/rlestat/hostgraph.aspx" style="border:0; width: 100%; height: 600px;" scrolling="no"></iframe>
```

Currently Connected Users

```
<iframe src="https://<serverfqdn>/rlestat/hostload.aspx?showusers=true" style="border:0; width: 100%; height: 500px;" scrolling="no"></iframe>
```

Finally, call the iframeresize script:

```
<script>
$(function () {
    iFrameResize();
});
</script>
```
